We continue to be in contact with the City to give us a date for removing the trees in the medians and re-planting with new trees and plants. We have also contracted with a water monitoring company to install moisture sensors on the slope along Triunfo to save money on our water bill. We hope to have the monitor installed and working in the next month or so.



ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

But don't forget to submit an Architectural Application to our Property Manager for any significant exterior remodeling or landscape modifications/improvements. The process is easy! Just go to our website at www.southshorehills.com and then on the navigation bar at the top, point to PMP PROPERTY MANAGEMENT. On the drop-down list, click SUBMIT AN ARCHITECTURAL REQUREST. You will be directed to the Owner Login page. If you have not already set up your

account, click the orange Sign Up button. Alternatively, call the PMP office and they will send you the application request form. The Architectural Committee is diligent about responding quickly to applications and requests!

BUDGET AND FINANCIALS



As we have reported, we have not been able to complete our 2018 and 2019 audits due to insufficient records provided by the past management company. Despite repeated requests, they have not complied with delivering the necessary records. We are still working to obtain these records and plan for our 2020 audit. All homeowners will receive the annual budget and copy of the reserve study at the end of the year.
